**NOTICE TO ALL LIMERICK RESIDENTS**

It is a requirement of the State of Maine Emergency Services Division that all roads have names and all physical driveways have 911 numbers assigned. If your road is missing the name sign and it is a public road, notify my office so we can replace it. If you live on a private road, it is the responsibility of the land owners to maintain a road sign.

The address numbers assigned to any individual for their property must be placed on both sides of their mailbox or on a post at the entrance to their driveway. It can also be placed on the dwelling unit, but only if the dwelling is close enough to the roadway that the number is clearly visible.

These numbers, regardless of where they are placed *must* be clearly visible from the road for emergency vehicles. Most importantly make sure you have the correct address (road name and number) for emergency services.
