MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

ATTENDEES

Dean LePage, C. Robert DeVilleneuve, Wendy Thorne, Charles Pellegrino, Frank Carroll Sr., and Joanne Andrews.

CALL TO ORDER

Dean called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. Welcome to the viewing audience and the flag salute.

HEARING OF CITIZENS

- Frank Carroll, Sr. submitted a quote from LaLonde Land Surveying, LLC in the amount of \$3,000.00 for additional work on the Town Line. The proposal is to place Town line signs or to verify the locations of existing signage at specified locations. Board to review with the Budget Committee.
- Charles Pellegrino followed up on his complaint of December 17th concerning CIA Salvage and his neon sign, hours of operation, contamination of groundwater and toxic fumes. Board directed him to the Board of Appeals.
- Judy LePage announced the open seats for candidates and that nomination papers are due back by January 22nd. Discussed the articles to be placed on secret ballot including a petition that she will be submitting for health insurance. Requested the Board to contact an electrician to change the wiring in her office to accommodate the use of her security windows.
- Joanne asked the Board to consider closing the Transfer Station and the Library on the day of the Town Meeting, Saturday, March 9th.
