

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

March 27, 2017

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

Joanne Andrews, John M. Medici and Roland C. LePage, Jr.

ATTENDEES:

- Dottie Richard, Judy LePage, Ron Phinney, Mike Mclean, Steve Malmude, Dean LePage, and Lisa LePage, Bill Jones, Mike Gilpatrick, Tawny Mann.

CALL TO ORDER:

Joanne called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded to accept** the Meeting Highlights of March 20, 2017, with a few adjustments. **All were in favor.**

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- **Lisa LePage – Parks and Rec.** Lisa has been trying to get ahold of Kyle at USA Lacrosse and not getting any answer. Selectmen Medici said Kyle is no longer with USA Lacrosse. Lisa said she will try their main number and speak with someone else concerning Grant money for a team for Limerick. Lisa presented and read a letter of resignation from Amanda LePage as Director for Parks and Rec. **A Motion was Made and seconded to accept Amanda's resignation. All were in favor. Selectwoman Andrews thanked Amanda for all her hard work.**
- **Mike McLean – Fire Chief,** presented quotes for the work that needs to be done to the Fire Department. Trim is first priority, Roof over entry door is second priority; the duct work can be put on hold for now. Mike said don't worry about the statement on quote requesting payment in full before job is started. **Motion was Made and seconded to approve both repair jobs on the fire department building by Josiah LaCourse. All were in favor.** Selectmen Medici told Mike to make sure Josiah LaCourse brings his insurance documents to the Selectmen's Office.
- **Ron Phinney – E911 Officer,** 2020 Censes information request needs to be taken care of. Ron thinks Mike will be too busy to handle Code Enforcement and the Censes Report. Selectmen Medici suggests hiring a part-time temp. person to help. Ron suggested putting concrete pillars around the new vault to protect it from snow plows and people backing into it.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:**OLD BUSINESS:**

- The Select Board had a workshop to discuss the advertising of vacancy's for volunteers on the Town of Limerick's Boards and Committees. Selectmen Medici doesn't like the current system because it allows Life Time Appointments, he would like to see a system which would allow people to apply for the volunteer positions on the Boards and/or Committees in a fashion that will be fair to everyone interested. After much discussion and due to the fact that appointments are up March 31st, **A Motion was Made and Seconded** to appoint the Fire Department Officials, The Animal Control Officer, The Code Enforcement Officer and his Alternate, The CEO-Shoreland Officer and Alternate, The Building Inspector and Alternate, The E911 Addressing Officer, The Health Officer, and The Plumbing Inspector and Alternate, for this week. **All were in favor.** The Select Board will put together a list to discuss next week.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Made a Motion to approve and Seconded a Bingo License for St. Matthews Church. All were in Favor.**
- **Made a Motion to approve and seconded an application for membership for MBOIA. All were in Favor.**
- Request to allow a business to put a flyer on the Bulletin Board at the municipal Building was denied. (This is not allowed.) Suggest the Limerick Supermarket and Post Office.

ASSESSING:**OTHER BUSINESS:**

- Selectwoman Andrews delivered a quote from Bob DeVilleneuve for the electrical work needed to install the ADA door opener, and Motion Sensors for the Lobby Lighting. **A Motion was Made and seconded to approve the quote for \$2335.00. All were in favor.**
- **Selectwoman Andrews shared information from a meeting she attended with the school superintendent's office, concerning next year's budget. The State is cutting \$920,000.000 leaving a 9.1% tax increase to property owners. This cut will affect the Ed. Tech positions. The Schools are fighting this budget cut, and there will be another meeting April 13th at 6:00 p.m. to continue the discussions.**
- **A Motion was made and seconded to accept the mail folder. All were in favor.**

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- John and Joanne Read the Announcements.

WARRANTS:

- **Motion was Made and Seconded** to accept the warrants as presented. **All were in favor.**

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Steve Malmude asked if the town was still going to use the concrete bunker for a vault, and are they not looking into the old bank building on Maine Street any longer? Also Steve asked how the problem came up concerning John & Marie Drive. Selectmen LePage explained that the board decided a while back that the bank building wouldn't work for several reasons. Selectmen Medici stated, assuming the bids come in within the budget, the town will move forward with the concrete bunker for the vault. About the concerns regarding John & Marie Drive, the road was never deeded properly to the town when it was accepted by the town in 2003. The select board has sent all the documents involved to the attorney to be sure what needs to be done is done correctly. The property owners involved are GIVING their land to the town (free of charge) to allow the problem to be corrected.
- Selectmen Medici stated that the Owner of the Cool Stuff store is interested in a lot, in the Industrial Park for a possible location for a Recreation Center for RCA (Radio Control Track) for events and races. Selectwoman Andrews stated that the couple that has the upholstery business have not contacted the town back regarding their interest in the Industrial Park, the board members are still trying to reach them by phone but haven't heard anything back.
- Judy LePage announced that the Town Clerk – Tax Collectors office will be closed Tuesday afternoon for a training workshop.

MEETING ADJOURNED:

- **Motion made and seconded** to adjourn the meeting. **All were in favor.** The Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
