MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

ATTENDEES:

CALL TO ORDER:

MINUTES:

- Dean met with Fire Chief Mclean on Wednesday, April 8th and reviewed the applications for the per diem firefighter/EMT position. An Executive Session will be held on April 29th to conduct the interviews.
- Dean will invite Sally Chandler, York County Commissioner, to attend a board meeting sometime in May to give an update of things going on in the County.
