MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

CALL TO ORDER

Wendy called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Welcome to the viewing audience and the flag salute

HEARING OF CITIZENS

- Adele Floyd has concerns regarding the damaged wall located next to her property that is owned by the state. The Board will check to see who to contact for the repairs.
- Jane Lougee Bryant stated she would have the sweeping of the parking lot completed in two (2) days. She also requested additional time of two days a week throughout the summer to continue with cleanup and raking. Board explained that this type of expense was not included in this year's budget and the matter could be possibly looked at for next year's budget.
- Michael Connolly came before the board with additional questions concerning the discontinuance of a portion of road on Doles Ridge Road. A Special Town Meeting has been scheduled for June 17th to discontinue that portion of the road but the easement will remain.
- Steve Malmude discussed the effects of motor boats on Sokokis Lake causing erosion of the shoreline, interfering with smaller vessels such as canoes, row boats, etc. Also had questions concerning the relationship between the lake association and the town.

- Sprinkler Systems Inspection Contract was tabled until late June when contract expires.
- Reviewed the new Snow Plowing Contract for the Municipal Building, Brick Town Hall-Fire Department, Transfer Station and Limerick Fire Station that will commence in October, 2013. Suggestions were made and the contract will be reviewed again at the next Board meeting.

- **Motion made and seconded** to purchase a portable camera in the amount of \$4,000.00 using franchise fees. All were in favor.
- Reviewed LD 1913 Worker's Comp Coverage. If a contractor cannot prove that they have their own insurance or provide a state approved predetermination of independent contractor status certificate, the town will not support them to contract work from the town. A letter addressing this issue will be mailed to all contractors.
- Public Notice for the sale of Lake Arrowhead properties was reviewed and approved for publication in the June 12th edition of the Shopping Guide.
- Received eight (8) job applications for Code Enforcement Clerk.
- **A motion was made and seconded** to approve the General Assistance Reimbursement Report for the month of May. All were in favor.
- Signed the Special Town Meeting Warrant (6 copies) that has been scheduled for June 17th.
