MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

CALL TO ORDER:

- Dean called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Meeting Highlights of July 20, 2015 as corrected. All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Laura May clarified inaccurate information stated by Selectmen at the July 20, 2015 BOS Meeting regarding the procedure for ordering Parks & Rec tee shirts.
- Joanne Andrews gave her report for the Transfer Station and how the “Take It Shop” is going strong.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Decision made to add Sonny’s new descriptions to the existing Sidewalk Snow Removal Contracts.
- Lisa LePage asked if there was a way to prevent and/or fix the erosion at Boy Scout Island.
- Bob Richardson said he would take care of the raking needed at the ballfield. Lisa LePage mentioned possibly being able to get free mulch.
- Joanne Andrews reported the town would be charged more for the one-year contract with Coastal Telephone. However, she didn’t feel it would be an increase in what the cost is now due to overages being charged by Fair Point.
- Joanne spoke with Portland Safe and they have sent the specifications for the vault/safe to the manufacturer and she will report the information when received.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to renew the contract with Modem Wavs for 20 hours. All were in favor.
- Dean LePage read a letter from Frank Carroll II to Norm Hutchins, CEO, asking for all correspondence regarding Steve McLean. Frank Carroll II stated Norm Hutchins is not doing his job in regard to pursuing Steve McLean's violations. Sonny LePage responded to Frank by stating there are procedures to be followed, and the CEO needs to determine if there are any violations. Sonny added that the whole process takes time. Joanne reported that Norm told the Planning Board he was doing fact finding according to the town attorney.
- Joanne Andrews read an email from an unhappy Todd Abbott at RSD Graphics regarding his services in providing tee-shirts.

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Steve Malmude asked the Selectmen if they held an illegal meeting on Friday, July 24, 2015 with Norm Hutchins. Dean LePage stated that the meeting was regarding a personnel issue and was not illegal.
- Joanne Andrews read the legal wording of what constitutes a "meeting" concerning the Board of Selectmen.
- Martha Hamilton Smith reminded the board of the necessity to have only one Selectmen present if the content of a meeting is a matter of substance and that it falls under "The Right to Know" guidelines.
- Several citizens voiced their opinions regarding the way the Board of Selectmen have been running the town. Bob Smyth stated that we all should be working for the good of the community, not the good of the individual.

- Board Reviewed Action, Pending and Bill Folders.
