MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

ATTENDEES:

CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Meeting Highlights of August 17, 2015 as corrected. Both were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

OLD BUSINESS:

- Sonny gave update on the Boston Post Cane. Letting the viewing audience know Kenneth Watson was still considered the recipient of the Boston Post Cane even though Mr. Watson passed away on Tuesday, August 11, 2015.
- Sonny read email from Cindy Smith stating the Municipal Building was found unlocked Tuesday, August 18, 2015.
- **Motion made and seconded** to authorize payment in the amount of \$6,995.00 to Alderwood Farms for work completed at the Limerick Business Park. Mike Carroll, Chairman of the Business Park Committee called on 08/24/2015 to say the Committee had approved the work as complete and gave go-ahead to pay contractor. Both were in favor.

Sonny replied that the locksmith is coming back to fix the problem. Steve mentioned that the personal attacks should be controlled by the BOS and not allowed.
