

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING

August 29, 2016

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

SELECTMEN IN ATTENDANCE:

CALL TO ORDER:

- Sonny called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Welcome to the viewing audience and flag salute.

MINUTES:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Meeting Highlights of August 22, 2016 as presented. All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

- Amanda LePage spoke on the Soccer Skills and Drills were complete and they had an excellent turn out. It is not too late to sign up to play. Applications are outside Rec Dept. door. Field was sprayed for yellow jackets. Some benches were moved and were requested if anyone moves them to return them to where they found them. There was graffiti found at the Public Beach along with remnants of fireworks and cigarettes. People are asked to be more respectful of the property. Steve Malmude mentioned to Amanda about the benches being unsafe if someone were to sit at the very end. He volunteered to adjust them for safety reasons. Chairman LePage approved of Steve to adjust the legs on the bench.

SCHEDULED SPEAKERS:

Lovedy Alexander President of the Research Club requested permission to use the Municipal Building grounds and restrooms for a yard sale on Saturday June 24, 2017 and a Music Festival and Ice Cream Social on July 4, 2017. Chairman LePage **motioned** and Selectman Andrews **seconded**. All were in favor.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Southern Maine Arbor Care estimate of \$1,300 was motioned by Selectman Andrews and **seconded** by Selectmen Medici. All were in favor.
- Appointed Steve Foglio to Tibbets Memorial Park Revitalization Sub Committee. Selectman Andrews **motioned** and Chairman LePage **seconded**. All were in favor.
- Lake Arrowhead properties approved for sale to abutters. Selectman Andrews **motioned**, Chairman LePage **seconded**. All were in favor.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Chairman LePage spoke of a thank you letter from Laurence Gross, Executive Director with Southern Maine Agency on Aging for the donation received from the Town.
- Rick Richardson and Charlie Pellegrino are working with Michael Carroll to install a cement footing to anchor the Port-a-Potty at the Public Beach because of all the vandalism that has been happening there. They hope to get it completed this week. Chairman LePage asked if they could also put some boulders around it to keep cars from knocking it over.
- Chairman LePage talked about the graffiti at the Public Beach. Selectman Medici will call the insurance company and then a graffiti removal company to clean up the wall. He will have the custodian paint the picnic table that was marked up.
- Discussion regarding generators
- Selectman Medici **motioned** to allow owner of Map 45 Lot 68A 30 days to redeem property after paying **all** back taxes and all costs incurred to date related to the property. Selectman Andrews **seconded**. All were in favor with Chairman LePage abstaining.
- Selectman Andrews **motioned** and Selectman Medici **seconded** the training request for Michael Gilpatrick. All were in favor.
- The Selectmen will meet briefly on Thursday, September 1st at 6:30 to set the 2017 Commitment.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Announcements were read by Selectmen Andrews.

HEARING OF CITIZENS:

- Steve Malmude spoke briefly regarding the Snowmobile Lease.
- The meeting was briefly suspended while Selectman Medici calls the Sheriff's Office.
- Steve McLean spoke regarding how the Town tries to employ local business when purchasing but for 35 years has not requested bids from him. He also talked about the Cummings Foundation.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- Reviewed Action, Pending and Bill folders.
- Selectman Medici **motioned** to obtain a restraining order against Steve Malmude to not allowing him to attend any public meetings in this building for the next six months. Selectman Andrews **seconded**. All were in favor

WARRANTS:

- **Motion made and seconded** to accept the Warrants as presented.

MEETING ADJOUNED:

- Selectman Medici **motioned**, Selectman Andrews **seconded** to adjourn the meeting. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:56 p.m.
