CALL TO ORDER

Wendy called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Welcome to the viewing audience and the flag salute

PUBLIC HEARING

- A Public Hearing was held for the renewal of a Class 1 Vinous Liquor License for the Clipper Merchant Tea House. Highlights are a separate document.

HEARING OF CITIZENS

- Michael Connolly, a local resident interested in purchasing land located on Doles Ridge Road came before the board with additional questions concerning the discontinuance of a portion of that road. A Special Town Meeting has been scheduled for June 17th to discontinue that portion of the road but the easement will remain.
- Jane Lougee Bryant asked for an extended time to complete the sweeping of the parking lot. Due to rainy conditions, she was unable to complete by the May 26th deadline. The Board approved the request.
- Denise Benton had questions concerning the auction of the town property. The Board not able to give an exact date at this time. Also had questions about a letter that was mailed last February to all homeowners in the Mobile Home Park from the CEO in regards to their 911 addresses. The Board was not familiar with the letter and will check with the code officer.
- Steve Grigg commented on the harvesting that had been done at the Transfer Station. Because there has been no clean up, he suggested that the area that was cleared be leveled off and perhaps grow grass in order to give it a better appearance.
